Here we are again at the pointy end of the season and that means Awards & Finals.

On behalf of the MPFNL Board, our thanks go to our partner the Melbourne Racing Club who hosted the Awards function at Mornington Racecourse on Monday 2 September and the AFLSE staff who so successfully ran the night. It was our biggest and best Awards Night yet with 340 in attendance and with the 3 Divisions of Women's footy involved for the first time. Another first was that a majority of our 4262 registered players this year, were women.

Congratulations to Warragul Industrials, Bonbeach and Frankston who took out the women's football premierships and congratulations to all our clubs as 24 out of the 25 clubs in our league were represented in finals.

Congratulations too to the winners of the 45 individual awards & teams of the year presented on the night, but the ultimate in plaudits must surely go to our Club volunteers who helped put on 1667 games of football and netball over season 2024.

The Board estimates that the voluntary hours devoted by Committee members alone this year was in the region of 125,000 and when combined with other Club volunteers the voluntary 8 hr days devoted to our competitions was a massive 30,000 +.

Why do our volunteers do it? They contribute to look after the physical and mental health of our youth, to provide first rate entertainment to our communities and to have fun in the process. We should not lose sight of the fact that all of this activity has a direct monetary contribution to the State's GDP of between \$10 -15 million and when added to the equivalent cost of our volunteers' labour, it amounts to a huge \$20-25m contribution.

Not only therefore should we be proud of the successes of our Clubs and our individual award winners but also of the contributions our volunteers make to our communities.

Good luck to those Clubs battling out finals.

162 days after Edithvale-Aspendale and Chelsea kicked off the division 2 season, it only feels right it is their job to finish it. After months of twists and turns, finally we get to see who will lift the trophy, and who will be playing division 1 footy in 2025. It has been a while between drinks for the Eagles, as they eye off their first premierships since 2013, and what a side they have to do it. It has been even longer for Chelsea, who haven't seen premierships since 2006, but do good things come to those who wait?

It has been over 20 weeks of pure dominance from Edi-Asp, not tasting defeat since their opening clash with the Seagulls. But even with the success of this year, the most important job is still yet to be done. Three meetings this year against Chelsea already has shown that the Eagles can beat the best, most notably their semi-final win to book their ticket to Kinetic Stadium. Six goals to one in the first term had their opponents on the back foot from the jump, and another huge run like that would be massive towards sending the premierships cup back to Regents Park. One look at the 2024 team of year tells you all you need to know about the unmatched talent of this Edi-Asp side, with Kris Pendlebury, Kurt Lo Po, Michael Meehan, Lewis Diggins and Alexander Browne's inclusions a scary sight for the Seagulls. With at least five of the league's very best to take to the field, the Seagulls need to have all bases covered to stop the Edi-Asp juggernaut. But, the minor premiers cannot afford to get complacent, with round 1 showing us that if anyone can do it, Chelsea can.

Eighteen years since their last appearance in the decider, but experience is no hinderance on this force of a Chelsea side. Any questions about the Seagulls' legitimacy as a contender were quickly dashed last weekend, with Chelsea's monster 103-

point victory over Somerville securing their spot on grand final day in fine style. The Seagulls' preliminary final victory exemplified how far this side has come, and how much more they have to give, bullying a strong Somy side from start to finish. The ever-reliable duo of John Simson (27 disposals and two goals) and skipper Todd Gardiner (25 and one goal) were immense once again, aided by the service of big man Jake Spasevski, who has helped transformed this Chelsea midfield into the number one clearance team in the competition. Sam Dorevitch has also been a major contributor to Chelsea's success with recent shutdown jobs on Joel Hillis and Mason De Wit, so reducing the influence of George Osborne medallist Kurt Lo Po would be crucial in nullifying the ladder-leaders' quick ball movement. A forward pack of Anthony Beale (41 goals), Jack Francis (39) and Jesse Davies (37 goals) is a terrifying sight for the Eagles, who cannot afford to give them too many chances. The fitness of Baxter Knight will be another thing to keep an eye on, adding more intrigue to a match that shapes as one of the best grand finals we have seen in a number of years.

#2 KURT LO PO

It has been a career-best year for the Eagles superstar, which has seen him recognised with the 2024 George Osborne Medal and a spot in the division 2 team of the year. Whether lining up in the middle or being thrown down forward, Lo Po always finds a way to impact the contest, making him a nightmare for opposition coaches. With Chelsea likely to have a plan up their sleeve, the Edi-Asp star could receive some attention on Saturday.

#5 KRIS PENDLEBURY

If there is one man that could single-handedly decide the premiership, it is Kris Pendlebury. After being only one of few players ever to enter the team of the year as a player and coach, Pendlebury's leadership and overall class is invaluable in such a big clash. Lining up off half-back, a strong performance from the playing-coach could lift his side to the ultimate prize.

#8 LEWIS DIGGINS

One of five Eagles to be inducted into the division 2 team of the year, Lewis Diggins has been right at the heart of Edi-Asp's successes so far this season. The Eagles' star will certainly be on Chelsea's radar, after kicking a match-winning bag of six at Chelsea Recreation Reserve in round 13. There are no questions about Diggins' hunt for the ball, and this is going to be crucial against a strong Chelsea midfield.

#20 MICHAEL MEEHAN

The Eagles forward is going to be a handful for Chelsea's defence. The former Sandringham sharpshooter's ability to hit the scoreboard cannot be questioned, having kicked 52 goals so far this year, the second most in the league. With multiple hauls so far this season, Meehan's ability to hit the scoreboard could ultimately decide the decider.

#23 TY VICKERY

With over 150 AFL goals and experience in big games, Vickery is a man built for this occasion. Despite not playing every game, the former Richmond and Hawthorn forward has made his presence felt every time he took to the field, kicking a goal in every game he has played in 2024. His ability to pinch-hit in the ruck adds another dimension to his game, causing more headaches for opposition defenders and ruckmen.

#5 JACK FRANCIS

One of four Seagulls to be selected in the team of the year, Francis has been a goal machine all season, averaging a team-high 2.2 goals per game. With eight goals so far in this finals series, and three in the semi-final, he is another one that Edi-Asp must to keep tabs on.

#11 JOHN SIMSON

What an addition John Simson has been. Since joining Chelsea from Clunes this season, the experienced midfielder has had an enormous impact in the Seagulls' midfield and their run to their first grand final since 2006. 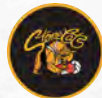
